Voter registration can also be made at any Secretary of State Branch Office or renewal by mail program; government agencies such as Department of Community Health, Department of Human Services, Agencies serving disabled persons or Michigan Rehabilitation Service Offices; or visit the Calhoun County Clerk's Office in Marshall, or their web site at: www.co.calhoun.mi.us to complete and print a voter registration application to mail to your county or local clerk.

Persons entitled to be registered voters in the County of Calhoun must possess the following qualifications on or before the day of the Election: 1) a citizen of the United States; 2) not less than 18 years of age; and 3) a resident of the State of Michigan and the local municipality for not less than 30 days prior to the Election (MCL 168.492). In addition, qualified electors must be registered to vote not less than 30 days prior to the Election (MCL 168.497).

Qualified electors who are unable to make personal application for registration may request a mail-in voter registration application form. Completed forms must be returned to their respective clerk no later than 5:00 p.m. Tuesday, October 9, 2018, or be postmarked on or before October 9, 2018, as provided for under Public Act 441 of 1994. Persons with special needs as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act should contact the clerk's office.

The following propositions will be submitted to the electors of the following districts at the election to be held Tuesday, November 6 2018 (the full text of the ballot propositions may be obtained at the County Clerk's office in Marshall, at their web address: www.co.calhoun.mi.us):

STATE PROPOSAL 18-1

A proposal initiated law to authorize and legalize possession, use and cultivation of marijuana products by individuals who are at least 21 years of age and older, and commercial sales of marijuana through state-licensed retailers

STATE PROPOSAL 18-2

A proposed constitutional amendment to establish a commission of citizens with exclusive authority to adopt district boundaries for the Michigan Senate, Michigan House of Representatives and U.S. Congress, every 10 years

STATE PROPOSAL 18-3

A proposal to authorize automatic and Election Day voter registration, no-reason absentee voting, and straight ticket voting; and add current legal requirements for military and overseas voting and post-election audits to the Michigan Constitution

FIRE STATION MILLAGE PROPOSAL A

Shall Tekonsha Township impose an increase of 1.8 mills (\$1.80 per \$1,000 of taxable value) in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution and levy it for thirty (30) years, 2019 through 2049, inclusive for construction of a new fire station to house the Fire Department & Marshall Area Fire Fighters Ambulance Authority, which 1.8 mills (\$1.80 per \$1,000 of taxable value) increase will raise an estimated \$90,795.65 in the first year the millage is levied.

TEKONSHA TOWNSHIP

FIRE STATION MILLAGE PROPOSAL B

Shall Tekonsha Township impose an increase of 1.6 mills (\$1.60 per \$1,000 of taxable value) in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution and levy it for thirty (30) years, 2019 through 2049, inclusive for construction of a new fire station **to house the Fire Department only**, which 1.6 mills (\$1.60 per \$1,000 of taxable value) increase will raise an estimated \$80,707.25 in the first year the millage is levied.
