2018 Gubernatorial Election Update

WHERE DO I VOTE ON ELECTION DAY?

All 60 precincts in Calhoun County will be open to conduct elections on Tuesday, November 6, 2018. The polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. through 8:00 p.m. Qualified voters standing in line at 8:00 p.m. will be permitted to vote. Each polling place is handicapped accessible and voting instructions are available in alternative formats such as Audio and Braille.

HAVE YOU MOVED RECENTLY?

If you are registered and 1) moved to a different precinct within the same city or township and 2) failed to change your registration address prior to October 9th, you are eligible to vote on last time in the precinct where you formerly lived. You will be asked to submit an address change form before you are issued a ballot.

If you moved to a different city or township less than 60 days prior to the election (September 7th) and failed to register to vote in your new city or township of residence by the registration deadline of October 9th, you are eligible to vote one last time in the precinct where you lived in your former city or township of residence. You will be asked to submit a registration cancellation authorization form before you are issued a ballot.

If you moved to a different city or township 60 days or more prior to the election (September 7th) and failed to register to vote in your new city or township of residence by October 9th, you are ineligible to vote in the November 6th election.

If you are uncertain of your precinct location, check your voter identification card, contact your local [city](#) or [township](#) clerk, or check on-line at Michigan.gov/vote. Precinct maps are also available on our [County Clerk-Elections webpage](#).
