The Board of Canvassers of the County of Calhoun, having Ascertained and Canvassed the Votes of said Tekonsha Township, at the Special Election, held on the 6th day of November, 2018.

DO HEREBY CERTIFY AND DETERMINE

That, Craig Clark, Republican, having received the largest number of votes, 540 (Five hundred forty) votes hereby elected to the office of Tekonsha Township Clerk for the remainder of the term ending November 20, 2020.

That, David C. Wright, Republican, having received the largest number of votes, 346 (Three hundred forty-six) votes hereby elected to the office of Tekonsha Township Trustee for the remainder of the term ending November 20, 2020.

That, Joyce M. Shaffer, having received the largest number of votes, 534 (Five hundred thirty-four) votes hereby elected to the office of Tekonsha Township Library Board Member for the remainder of the term ending November 20, 2020.

That, Thomas Bowling, having received the largest number of votes, 221 (Two hundred twenty-one) votes hereby elected to the office of Tekonsha Village President for a two year term ending November 20, 2020.

That, Debra Taylor, having received the largest number of votes, 221 (Two hundred twenty-one) votes hereby elected to the office of Tekonsha Village Clerk for a two year term ending November 20, 2020.

That, Rose K. Bush, having received the largest number of votes, 217 (Two hundred seventeen) votes hereby elected to the office of Tekonsha Village Treasurer for a two year term ending November 20, 2020.

That, Denis C. Bush, having received a sufficient number of votes, 171 (One hundred seventy-one) is hereby elected to the office of Tekonsha Village Trustee for a four year term ending November 20, 2022.

That, Michael T. Eisenberg, having received a sufficient number of votes, 169 (One hundred sixty-nine) is hereby elected to the office of Tekonsha Village Trustee for a four year term ending November 20, 2022.

That, Barbara Calhoun, having received a sufficient number of votes, 6 (Six) is hereby elected to the office of Tekonsha Village Trustee for a four year term ending November 20, 2022.

That, no candidate received votes for the office of Tekonsha Village Trustee for a partial term ending November 20, 2020.

That Tekonsha Township Fire Station Millage Proposal A, an increase of 1.8 mills for 30 years, received 375 (Three hundred seventy-five) NO votes, thus is DEFEATED.

Shall Tekonsha Township impose an increase of 1.8 mills (\$1.80 per \$1,000 of taxable value) in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution and levy it for thirty (30) years, 2019 through 2049, inclusive for construction of a new fire station to house the Fire Department & Marshall Area Fire Fighters Ambulance Authority, which 1.8 mills (\$1.80 per \$1,000 of taxable value) increase will raise an estimated \$90,795.65 in the first year the millage is levied.

That Tekonsha Township Fire Station Millage Proposal B, an increase of 1.6 mills for 30 years, received 390 (Three hundred ninety) NO votes, thus is DEFEATED.

Shall Tekonsha Township impose an increase of 1.6 mills (\$1.60 per \$1,000 of taxable value) in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution and levy it for thirty (30) years, 2019 through 2049, inclusive for construction of a new fire station to house the Fire Department only, which 1.6 mills (\$1.60 per \$1,000 of taxable value) increase will raise an estimated \$80,707.25 in the first year the millage is levied.
