To the qualified electors of **Pennfield Schools**
in the Counties of Calhoun and Barry, State of Michigan:

Notice is hereby given that a Special Election will be held on Tuesday, May 2, 2017. The last day on which persons may register for the election is, **MONDAY, APRIL 3, 2017**. Voter registration can also be made at any Secretary of State Branch Office or renewal by mail program; government agencies such as Department of Community Health, Department of Human Services, agencies serving disabled persons or Michigan Rehabilitation Service offices; or visit the Calhoun County Clerk's Office in Marshall or their web site at www.co.calhoun.mi.us to complete and print a voter registration application to mail to your county or local clerk.

Persons entitled to be registered voters must possess the following qualifications on or before the day of the Election: 1) a citizen of the United States; 2) not less than 18 years of age; and 3) a resident of the State of Michigan and the local municipality for not less than 30 days prior to the Election (MCL 168.492). In addition, qualified electors must be registered to vote not less than 30 days prior to the Election (MCL 168.497).

Qualified electors who are unable to make personal application for registration may request a mail-in voter registration application form. Completed forms must be returned to their respective clerk no later than 5:00 pm Monday, April 3, 2017, or be postmarked on or before April 3, 2017, as provided for under Public Act 441 of 1994. Persons with special needs as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act should contact the clerk's office.

The following proposition will be submitted to the electors of Pennfield Schools at the Special Election to be held Tuesday, May 2, 2017:

PENNFIELD SCHOOLS
GENERAL OBLIGATION UNLIMITED TAX BOND PROPOSAL FOR BUILDING AND SITE PURPOSES
IN THE AMOUNT OF NOT TO EXCEED \$8,600,000.
