

NOVEMBER 7, 2017 CITY AND SPECIAL ELECTIONS

PRECINCT LOCATIONS

Based on the complexity of the ballot and expected voter turnout, in addition to saving costs to the taxpayers, we have consolidated the following precincts for this one election only:

In the City of Battle Creek:

Precinct 1 at Trinity Lutheran Church

Precincts 2 and 3 combined at Battle Creek First Assembly of God. (2,958 reg. voters)

Precincts 4 and 10 combined at Christ United Methodist Church. (3,785 reg. voters)

Precincts 5 and 20 combined at First Wesleyan Church. (3,267 reg. voters)

Precincts 6 and 9 combined at Chapel Hill United Methodist Church. (3,018 reg. voters)

Precincts 7 and 13 combined at Trinity United Methodist Church. (3,034 reg. voters)

Precinct 8 at St. Peter Lutheran Church

Precinct 11 at First Wesleyan Church

Precincts 12 and 21 combined at Second Baptist Missionary Church. (3,755 reg. voters)

Precincts 15, 16 and 17 combined at Emmett Street Missionary Church. (4,243 reg. voters)

Precinct 18 at Cherry Hill Manor

Precinct 19 at Maple United Methodist Church

Precincts 22 and 23 combined at Battle Creek First Assembly of God. (3,190 reg. voters)

In the City of Springfield:

Precincts 1 and 2 combined at Springfield City Hall. (3,086 reg. voters)

In Bedford Charter Township:

All Hastings Area School System electors will be voting in Johnstown Township in Barry County; the Township Hall is located at 13641 S. M-37 Highway, Battle Creek.

In Tekonsha Community Schools:

Burlington Township (39 registered voters), Clarendon Township (129 registered voters), and Fredonia Township (54 registered voters) will all be voting at Tekonsha Township (1,421 total registered voters).

Butler and Girard Townships in Branch County (in the Tekonsha Community School District) will be open to conduct the Coldwater School Election as well as the Tekonsha School election.
