### January 9<sup>th</sup> Deadline

.... for local election commissions to finalize precinct boundaries for 2018 election cycle



### March 26<sup>th</sup> 5:00 pm, Filing Deadline

.... for Incumbent Judicial Candidates (one 37<sup>th</sup> Circuit Court Judge position/Hallacy s



### By April 1<sup>st</sup> 5:00 pm Deadline

.... for county political party chairpersons to certify precinct delegate allocation c



### April 24<sup>th</sup> 4:00 pm, Filing Deadline

.... for Partisan (Republican, Democratic and Libertarian Party) and Nonpartisan Candidates seeking nomination to State, County Commission, and partial term Township offices  
.... Non-incumbent Judicial Candidates (one 10<sup>th</sup> District Court Judge position/Norlander) s



### May 8<sup>th</sup> Special Election

.... Last day recall petitions can be filed is February 2<sup>nd</sup> c  
Proposal filing deadline is February 13<sup>th</sup> by 4:00 pm  
Final date cities/townships can establish, move or abolish a polling place: March 9<sup>th</sup>  
Send MOVE and other Absent Voter Ballots by March 24<sup>th</sup>  
Local election commission appoints precinct inspectors between March 29<sup>th</sup> and April 17<sup>th</sup>  
Close of Registration Notice published and posted by April 2<sup>nd</sup>. Last Day to Register April 9<sup>th</sup>  
Notice of Election published and posted by May 1<sup>st</sup>  
Public accuracy test must be conducted by May 3<sup>rd</sup> (48 hour notice required)  
Deadline for electors to apply to receive an AV ballot by mail: May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2:00 pm  
Deadline for AV electors to vote in person in your office: May 7<sup>th</sup>, 4:00 pm  
County Canvass of Election Results will begin May 10<sup>th</sup>, 9:00 am  
Within 7 days after Certification of election results, upload Voter History in QVF, and delete EPB software and files.

### August 7<sup>th</sup> Primary Election

.... Proposal filing deadline is May 15<sup>th</sup> by 4:00 pm  
Final date cities/townships can establish, move or abolish a polling place: June 8<sup>th</sup>  
Proposal deadline for Constitutional Amendments/Legislative Referendums by June 8<sup>th</sup> s  
Send MOVE and other Absent Voter Ballots by June 23<sup>rd</sup>  
Local election commission appoints precinct inspectors between June 28<sup>th</sup> and July 17<sup>th</sup>  
Close of Registration Notice published and posted by July 2<sup>nd</sup>. Last Day to Register July 9<sup>th</sup>  
Filing deadline for Write-in candidates is July 27<sup>th</sup>, 4:00 pm  
Notice of Election published and posted by July 31<sup>st</sup>  
Public accuracy test must be conducted by August 2<sup>nd</sup> (48 hour notice required)  
Filing deadline for Write-in Precinct Delegate candidates, **file with City/Township Clerk**, Aug. 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4 pm  
Deadline for electors to apply to receive an AV ballot by mail: August 4<sup>th</sup>, 2pm  
Deadline for AV electors to vote in person in your office: August 6<sup>th</sup>, 4pm  
County Canvass of Election Results will begin August 8<sup>th</sup>, 1:00 pm  
Within 7 days after Certification of election results, upload Voter History in QVF  
County clerks notify precinct delegates elected at August primary by August 14<sup>th</sup>, certify to county committees  
State Canvass of Election Results August 27<sup>th</sup> s  
By 7<sup>th</sup> calendar day following State Certification delete EPB software and files, unless audited

- .... Filing deadline for candidates without party affiliation seeking State, County Commission, and partial term Township offices Partisan offices, July 19<sup>th</sup>, 4:00 pm
- Filing deadline for village, school, and community college candidates, July 24<sup>th</sup>, 4:00 pm
- Last day recall petitions can be filed is August 3<sup>rd</sup> **c**
- Proposal filing deadline is August 14<sup>th</sup> by 4:00 pm
- Final date cities/townships can establish, move or abolish a polling place: September 7<sup>th</sup>
- Republican, Democratic and Libertarian Party Fall State Conventions held by September 7<sup>th</sup> **s**
- Proposal deadline for Constitutional Amendments and Legislative Referendums by September 7<sup>th</sup> **s**
- Send MOVE and other Absent Voter Ballots by September 22<sup>nd</sup>
- Local election commission appoints precinct inspectors between September 27<sup>th</sup> and October 16<sup>th</sup>
- Close of Registration Notice published and posted by October 2<sup>nd</sup>. Last Day to Register October 9<sup>th</sup>
- Filing deadline for Write-in candidates is October 26<sup>th</sup>, 4:00 pm
- Notice of Election published and posted by October 30<sup>th</sup>
- Public accuracy test must be conducted by November 1<sup>st</sup> (48 hour notice required)
- Deadline for electors to apply to receive an AV ballot by mail: November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2:00 pm
- Deadline for AV electors to vote in person in your office: November 5<sup>th</sup>, 4:00 pm
- County Canvass of Election Results will begin November 7<sup>th</sup>, 1:00 pm
- Within 7 days after Certification of election results, upload Voter History in QVF
- State Canvass of Election Results November 26<sup>th</sup> **s**
- By 7<sup>th</sup> calendar day following State Certification delete EPB software and files
