Voter registration can also be made at any Secretary of State Branch Office or renewal by mail program; government agencies such as Dept. of Community Health, Family Independent Agency, agencies serving disabled persons or Michigan Rehabilitation Service offices; armed forces recruitment offices; or visit the County Clerk's Office in Marshall or their web site at [www.co.calhoun.mi.us](http://www.co.calhoun.mi.us) to complete and print a voter registration application to mail to your county or local clerk.

Persons entitled to be registered voters in the County of Calhoun must possess the following qualifications on or before the day of the Election: 1) a citizen of the United States; 2) not less than 18 years of age; and 3) a resident of the State of Michigan and the local municipality for not less than 30 days prior to the Election (MCL 168.492). In addition, qualified electors must be registered to vote not less than 30 days prior to the Election (MCL 168.497).
